Fire and Sprinkler Burn Demonstration \$1,000 Stipend Program

With funding through a 2011 Fire Prevention and Safety Grant awarded by the Grant Programs Directorate of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), HFSC will carry out a national program to increase awareness of home fire sprinkler system facts and advance the use of an effective local public education tool: live flashover and sprinkler burn demonstrations.

To receive the \$1,000 stipend you must agree to implement your event and fulfill the Event Implementation Requirements by.

Event Implementation Requirements: You must agree to implement and host a live burn demonstration event utilizing the HFSC Fire and Sprinkler Burn Demonstration Kit. You must ensure the event contains home fire sprinkler educational outreach; endeavor to extend the educational benefit beyond the actual event (such as through placement of photos or video on the department's website), evaluate the educational effectiveness of the event; and report event summary and evaluation findings to HFSC.

The \$1,000 burn stipend must be used to pay for the costs of supplies to build, furnish and conduct the fire and sprinkler burn demonstration, labor and any costs to promote the program. As part of the evaluation, you will be required to provide a summary of how the \$1,000 stipend was utilized and encouraged to file your receipts for three years as requested by the Grant Programs Directorate of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).

To accept this agreement:

1. Complete the statement below with your name, fire department name and address and the **date you plan to conduct the event**. Note, the \$1,000 check will be written to the name and address you insert in this statement. It must match the information provided on the application.
