

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Rutherford County Highway Department is responsible for certain county roads in Rutherford County, Tennessee, and

WHEREAS, T.C.A. 55-8-153 authorizes the Rutherford County Commission to prescribe speed limits as it may deem appropriate on any road being maintained by Rutherford County and authorizes it to erect appropriate signs, and

WHEREAS, the Rutherford County Highway Department has recommended and requested a 40 mile per hour speed limit with appropriate signage be posted on Puckett Road, a designated county road, and

WHEREAS, the Public Works & Planning Committee has recommended said speed limit be imposed for the safety and welfare of the citizens of Rutherford County, Tennessee and the maintenance and preservation of this county road and persons traveling thereon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Rutherford County Board of Commissioners as follows:

1. That the maximum speed limit be and the same shall hereafter be 40 miles per hour for all motor vehicles traveling on Puckett Road, said speed limit being deemed appropriate and reasonable by the Rutherford County Commission upon recommendation of the Rutherford County Highway Department pursuant to T.C.A. 55-8-153.
