This agency combines the local resources of Rutherford County, the City of Murfreesboro, the Town of Smyrna, and the City of LaVergne; along with State and Federal resources to mitigate, prepare for, respond to, and recover from the effects all types of emergencies including natural or man-made disasters, technological accidents, national security threats, and other disrupting incidents that may impact our area or the general populations.

Blue Angel Crash

Multiple response agencies were at the Smyrna Airport preparing for the air show coming up over the weekend. The Blue Angels had lifted off for their second practice run of the day. At approximately 3:01pm Jet #6 lost control on a power up climb off of SE runway 32 and crashed approximately one mile in a straight line from the runway. The debris field stretched approximately 600 yards from 35°59'23.75"N x 86°30'1.03"W SE of the Sam Davis home, across a field to the North of the home and through several tree lines to 35°59'40.78"N x 86°30'12.07"W on the back nine of the golf course. The pilot was deceased on impact and all fuel was consumed in the explosion. Units quickly arrived on scene where pockets of fire was still involved. The scene was confined and contained as a crime scene, and incident command established behind the Sam Davis home. Media was directed to the Smyrna Elementary School for briefings. An official release was issued by the US Navy from Pensacola. The incident is currently under federal investigation.




EMA responded to the Murfreesboro Waste Water Treatment Plant where the WWTD Sinking Creek 4D expansion is taking place to a reported worker injured in a 20 foot hole. The victim had been working on a trough in a containment area when reportedly a 2x4 fell and hit the worker in the head. This impact reportedly caused his helmet to fall off and the victim then hit the ground on his head. The party, Mr. Firmo Dominguez, 47yr old Hispanic male, dob 06/01/69 was conscious and in stable condition and transported to Vanderbilt Medical Center via Life Flight.
