The Rutherford County Correctional Work Center Board met for their monthly board meeting on Monday, August 1, 2016.

**C) APPROVE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING**

The first matter before the Board was the minutes of the July 11, 2016 meeting. After discussion, Mr. Rudd moved that the minutes of July 11, 2016 meeting be approved as published. Seconded by Mr. Asbury. The motion carried unanimously with favorable votes.

**D) EXPENDITURE REPORT**

The Board was provided with the June account analysis report, June litter pickup, ABL and ICS Solutions commission checks, June figures for the yearly activity report, and July monthly worker report. After discussion, Mr. Asbury moved that the expenditure report be approved as published. Seconded by Mrs. Mosby. The motion carried unanimously with favorable votes.

**E) OTHER BUSINESS, IF ANY**

Superintendent noted George Medley an evangelist/motivational speaker travels the world and stopped in to speak to the inmates.

The Bureau of Justice Assistance Grant was approved and carries us to the end of the year. Mayor Burgess noted the county is prepared to pickup after the current VBHCS grant runs out. The Guidance Center staff has been very successful with the inmate program. Superintendent noted Kara Conner helps released inmates with obtaining housing, getting their drivers license reinstated, etc.

Captain Cope noted CADCOR, which deals mainly with substance abuse, is working on a \$2 million grant. They are currently working with us at no cost to the county.

Superintendent noted the work release program is going strong. The staff is currently working with two companies: Four Winds Pool and Spa Company and Kasai of North America which manufactures parts for Nissan is interested in 100 inmates (employees). Mayor noted even if we need to provide transportation for inmates to go to the Kasai's Manchester plant to keep that option open and no one on the Board objected.

Superintendent noted we are having an Employee Appreciation Ice Cream Social on Saturday, August 27, 2016 at noon in the big classroom and invited the Board to attend.

Mayor Burgess suggested Superintendent speak with Ben Mankin regarding paving the work center's parking lot or at the minimum repairing the holes in the asphalt.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 8:50am.


