This agency combines the local resources of Rutherford County, the City of Murfreesboro, the Town of Smyrna, and the City of LaVergne; along with State and Federal resources to mitigate, prepare for, respond to, and recover from the effects all types of emergencies including natural or man-made disasters, technological accidents, national security threats, and other disrupting incidents that may impact our area or the general populations.

Narrative: EMA was notified by SO Dispatch that 30-40 gallons of diesel fuel were on the ground as a result of a traffic accident. 601 (Tharrel Kast) responded. Units on-scene were Smyrna PD and Fire and they reported there was only about 3-4 gallons of fuel spilled had been cleaned up.
