EXPLANATION FOR ABOVE AMENDMENT REQUEST

- 1) The diesel line is tracking approximately \$4,000 per month. At this rate, this line item will be underfunded by approximately 24,000. This request is to appropriate \$12,000 from the pooled gas account to the diesel account for the County Fire Department. We will continue to monitor usage, but may have to request additional funds in four-five months.
- 2) Effective January 1, 2013, Rockvale Volunteer Fire Department desires to merge their operations in to the Rutherford County Fire and Rescue department. The above amendment redistributes the county's contract amount budgeted to Rockvale Volunteer Fire department to diesel, communications, utilities, and other supplies.
