MVA- I-24 E @ 89

At 6:30 pm EMA was requested to respond to I-24 east at mm 89 for an MVA. A tractor trailer towing a large excavator with the arm extended and impacted the I beam of the bridge overpass causing extensive damage to the bridge, breaking the truck axel in half, and destroying the excavator. An unknown amount diesel fuel and hydraulic oil impacted the soil at the shoulder of the road. The bridge was shut down and after inspection by TDOT only one lane was re-opened until further integrity could be determined. The interstate was reduced to one lane temporarily in order to the fire department to flush a large amount of debris out of the road. The owner operator, Mr. Keith Hieb of Heib Farms, 423-503-5568 contracted with Eagle SWS for clean up. TEMA incident #313 assigned.
