TEMA received the 2013 Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) information the week of May 20, 2013, I assure you that we realize that this critical funding stream for emergency management has not been provided to the State in a timely fashion. Our staff, along with the Regional Directors, met in accordance with the established protocols to determine the county allocations. The 2013 EMPG grant to the State is roughly \$134,000 less than the 2012 grant and we have determined that it is in the best interest of the Statewide Emergency Management Program for TEMA to absorb this reduction in order to fund counties at roughly their 2012 levels unless local budgets reduce that level. The 2013 funding for Rutherford County is \$ 64,350.00.

The total 2013 EMPG Grant to the State of TN is \$6,541,836 and we are passing a total of \$2,898,723 to Local Governments to help fund local Emergency Management Programs. This represents a 44% pass through to Local Governments.

I appreciate your continued support for your Local Emergency Management Programs.
