Reference: TOSHA complaint and Inspection

Dear Mayor Burgess:

Rutherford County Government was recently informed, by the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development, Occupational Safety and Health Administration (TOSHA), of a complaint listing serious safety and health hazards at the County Landfill and Convenience Centers. The complaint dated April 3, 2013 listed fifteen concerns of the filing party. TOSHA followed up on the complaint on April 19, 2013 when they conducted an on-site inspection of the Landfill and selected Convenience Center locations.

Following the inspection only three of the original fifteen concerns were cited as a violation under the OSHA standards. One concern, smoking in the shop area, is not an OSHA violation and was referred to another department for further investigation. During the April 19th inspection the TOSHA inspector observed additional violations not listed in the initial complaint but were included in the final report. The final report contains nine serious and three non-serious violations. All violations have been corrected and the abatement verification forms filed prior the required completion date of June 22, 2013.

Dear Mayor Burgess:

On April 19, 2013, our compliance officer, Bridgett McBride, conducted an investigation of Rutherford County-Landfill, as a result of a complaint received in our office. The results of our inspection of the complaint items are as follows:

CSHO Response to the Complaint

1. Complaint-No Hazard Communication Program and No Material Safety Data Sheets book.

Response-On the day of the inspection, it was determined that a Hazard Communication Program was developed and implemented. In addition, Material Safety Data Sheets were observed and maintained on the job site. A citation will not be recommended because no employee exposure could be documented for this item.

2. Complaint-No Hazardous Response Book or Emergency Action Plan.

Response- On the day of the inspection, the CSHOs observed an Operation Manual and Construction Requirement for Sanitary Landfill and a Rutherford County Emergency Procedures Flip Chart that employees would use in the event of an emergency. A citation would not be recommended for this item.

3. Complaint-No Lockout/Tagout Programs.

Response: On the day of the inspection, it was determined that there was not a lockout/tag-out program developed for employees who services and maintenance a Back hoe, Bull Dozer and Trash Compactors. A citation would be recommended for this item.

4. **Complaint-No Safety gear such as reflective vest; safety glass or goggles; gloves; hard hats (note: heavy equipment operators are allowed to wear tennis shoes at the landfill).**

Response: On the day of the inspection, CSHO's observed personnel protective equipment (ppe) such as reflective vest, safety glasses, goggles, gloves and hard hats. An employee was observed wearing steel toe boots on the job site. During interviews both employer and employees both stated that employees are to wear their ppe and steel toe shoes in the work shop area and when operating heavy equipment. A citation will not be recommended because no employee exposure could be documented for this item.

5. **Complaint-Open containers of chemicals and mixing of materials on shelf very dangerous.**

Response: On the day of the inspection, there were no open containers observed of chemicals and mixing of materials on shelf that were very dangerous. During the employee interviews, it was revealed that they do not mix any chemicals or materials. A citation will not be recommended because no employee exposure could be documented for this item.

6. **Complaint-No chemical training.**

Response: On the day of the inspection, it was determined that employees received Hazard Communication and Hazardous Material training on September 17 and 20, 2012. During the employee interviews, it was revealed to the CSHO's that they received training on chemicals through the Hazard Communication and Hazardous Material training. They indicated that all training was conducted by their employer. The employer stated that employee training was set up on a computer base time line training system. The employer stated that the system informs them of when one of the various safety or health topics that employees need to be trained on. In addition, the system documents their training. A citation will not be recommended because no employee exposure could be documented for this item.

7. **Complaint-No eye wash, no eye wash station or shower.**

Response: On the day of the inspection, the CSHOs did not observed any corrosive chemicals on the jobsite to determine if an eye wash station or shower would be needed. A citation will not be recommended because no employee exposure could be documented for this item.

8. **Complaint-No one trained in first aid and blood borne pathogens.**

Response: On the day of the inspection, the CSHOs observed a first aid kit inside the Work Shop area of the Rutherford County-Landfill. It was indicated that employees were not trained on first aid. The employer stated that the closest emergency medical center was less than 3 minutes from the jobsite. The landfill being near an emergency medical center there is no requirement for a person to be trained on first aid according to the standard. The employer stated that Furthermore, employees received annually training on blood borne pathogens by the employer. A citation will not be recommended because no employee exposure could be documented for this item.

9. Complaint-No employee training conducted.

Response: During the inspection, it was determined that employee training was conducted. The employer provided documentation of employee training to the CSHOs. In addition, employee interviews revealed that the employer conducts employee training on various safety and health topics annually. A citation will not be recommended because no employee exposure could be documented for this item.

10. Complaint-No Safety Work Rules are enforced.

Response: During the inspection, it was revealed to the CSHOs that Safety Work Rules were enforced. The employer provided a copy of the rules to the CSHOs during the inspection. A citation will not be recommended because no employee exposure could be documented for this item.

11. Complaint-No "Smoking Rule" is not enforced.

Response: During the inspection, it was revealed that an employee had been smoking inside of the main office. There was no smoking sign posted. During the inspection, the employer stated that he was not aware of the No smoking law. The CSHOs informed the employer that the Non-Smoker Protection Act went into effect on Monday, October 1, 2007. The Department of Labor & Workforce Development along with the Department of Health has the responsibility to enforce this Act. This item will be recommended to the TOSHA's Legal Department for further investigation.

12. Complaint-Water heater sparks when you walk by it.

Response- On the day of the inspection, the CSHOs observed the water heater and walked by it. The water heater did not spark. During the interviews, both the employer and employees stated that they were not aware of the water heater ever sparked when a person walk by it. A citation will not be recommended because no employee exposure could be documented for this item.

13. Complaint-OSHA Poster not updated

Response: On the day of the inspection, OSHA poster was observed updated and posted inside of the Work Shop Area of the Rutherford County-Landfill. A citation will not be recommended because no employee exposure could be documented for this item.

14. Complaint-No Carbon Monoxide and welding signs.

Response-On the day of the inspection, there was no carbon monoxide or welding signs posted inside of the Work Shop Area of the Rutherford County-Landfill. A citation would be recommended for this item.

15. Complaint-No respirator protection.

Response- On the day of the inspection, it was determined that Rutherford County had a respirator program established. The employees at the Rutherford County-Landfill are not exposed to any high toxic or corrosive chemical on the jobsite that would require them to wear a full-face respirator. They wear P95 NIOSH 3m 8577 Dust Mask and MSA Safety Works Dust Mask for Non-Toxic Dust voluntarily. The employer and employees both indicated that dust masks were worn voluntarily. A citation will be recommended because the employer did not inform employees of the information contained in Appendix D.

Our goal is to help you provide a safe and healthful work environment for your employees. We are confident this activity will facilitate the continued growth of your safety and health program and help to reduce workplace injuries and illnesses.

During this visit violation(s) of the OSHA standards were observed in the areas we inspected. These violation(s) do not imply that your program is ineffective; however, they are an indication of a program deficiency in some aspect of your safety and health program. We have included with this report a "Notice of Unsafe or Unhealthful Working Conditions" that contains 12 (twelve) violation(s) observed during this visit. Please post a copy of this Notice for your employees to view for a period of at least three (3) working days, or until all alleged violation(s) are corrected. We will need your reply as to the corrective action taken or planned by the abatement date indicated on the Notice.

Enclosed are copies of the Abatement Certification Form with instructions. This form should be used to report the action you take to correct the violation(s).

Your file cannot be closed until we have documentation of correction of each violation. Please respond promptly.

On April 19, 2013, a Complaint inspection of your establishment/workplace was conducted by Bridgett McBride as a result of a Complaint received in our office. The enclosed report contains the results of that visit. The report may contain violation(s) of standards and/or rules promulgated under the provisions of this Code. These alleged violations must be corrected on or before the date shown beneath each violation description listed thereon.

EMPLOYER RESPONSIBILITIES

The Department of Labor and Workforce Development Rules require this Notice (or a copy) to be immediately posted in a prominent place at or near the place where each alleged violation occurred. The Notice shall remain posted until the alleged violation is corrected or for a minimum of three (3) working days whichever is longer.

Employers must notify the Manager of Public Sector Programs, Division of Occupational Safety and Health, when correction of each alleged violation(s) has been completed. You have the right to request an extension of the correction period(s) when you cannot correct the alleged violation(s) by the prescribed correction date because of circumstances beyond your control. On April 19, 2013, the work rest on a 8" DeWalt Bench Grinder, DW756, 3/4 HP, 3450 RPM, serial # 200413-YL1487 was not adjusted closely to the abrasive wheel with a maximum opening of 1/8" from the grinding wheel. The bench grinder was located in the Work Shop of the Rutherford County-Landfill.

On April 19, 2013, there was not a tongue guard on the 8" DeWalt Bench Grinder, DW756, 3/4HP, 3450 RPM, serial #200413-YL1487 in order for it to be adjusted closely to the abrasive wheel with a maximum opening of 1/4" from the grinding wheel. The bench grinder was located in the Work Shop Area of the Rutherford County-Landfill.

29 CFR 1910.147(c)(1): The employer did not establish a program consisting of an energy control procedure and employee training to ensure that before any employee performed any servicing or maintenance on a machine or equipment where the unexpected energizing, start up or release of stored energy could occur and cause injury, the machine or equipment would be isolated, and rendered inoperative.

On April 19, 2013, that the employer did not establish a Lockout/Tagout Program consisting of an energy control procedure and employee training before employees performed servicing and maintenance on John Deere 310SG Black Hoe/Front End Loader, Caterpillar Bull Dozer D7R Cat#616 and Trash Compactors.

On April 19, 2013, the 1200 gallon diesel and gasoline tanks, located at the Rutherford County-Landfill, were not labeled identifying its contents. Containers of chemicals need to be conspicuously marked with its contents to avoid mixing of chemicals that may react in a hazardous manner.

Violation 1 Item 9 Type of Violation: **Serious**

TDLWD Rule 0800-1-9-.06(2): The employer failed to ensure that work areas in which non-containerized hazardous chemicals are generated or produced as a result of the process or operation taking place in such work area (e.g., welding fumes, carbon monoxide from powered industrial trucks exhaust, etc.) contain a sign or placard identifying the hazardous chemical(s) and appropriate hazard warnings.

On April 19, 2013, the employer failed to post Carbon Monoxide signs and Welding Fumes signs. Welding operations and Gasoline powered equipment is being started inside the building. There were no signs warning employees of the possible dangers from the presence of these fumes and gases located in the Work Shop Area of the Rutherford County-Landfill.


