

**RUTHERFORD COUNTY, TENNESSEE
CORRECTIONAL WORK CENTER MINUTES
SEPTEMBER 9, 2013
8:30 A.M.**

The Rutherford County Correctional Work Center Board met for their monthly board meeting on Monday, September 9, 2013.

A) MEETING CALLED TO ORDER

Chairman Ernest Burgess called the meeting to order at 8:00 am.

B) ROLL CALL

C) APPROVE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING

Mr. Asbury moved that the minutes of the August 5, 2013 meeting be approved as corrected. Seconded by Mrs. Mosby. The motion carried unanimously with favorable votes.

D) REPORT OF EXPENDITURES

The Board was presented with the litter pickup report, board bill, yearly activity report, ABL & IC Solutions commission reports, general session's bill and Smyrna's general sessions check, monthly worker reports, board bill, general session's bill, and the account analysis. Superintendent noted all lines look good with the exception of 101-54220-338, vehicle repairs, due to one of the county vehicles needing a transmission. After discussion, Mr. Hartley moved that the Report of Expenditures be approved. Seconded by Mr. Asbury. The motion carried unanimously with favorable votes.

E) OTHER BUSINESS, IF ANY

Mayor Burgess noted a budget amendment was done at the last Finance meeting to cover Dr. Rudd's indirect cost. Mayor Burgess advised that the county had contracts with Dr. Rudd at all three of the correctional facilities. He advised that the net effect of the request was between the Work Center and the Jail. For the previous year, the county owed Dr. Rudd a net of \$58,274.66. Dr. Rudd owed the county \$18,894.24 for the jail, and the county owed Dr. Rudd \$77,168.90 for a net of \$58,274.66. With this history, it would appear that approximately \$60,000 in additional funding would be needed for the 2013-14 fiscal year for indirect costs and off-site medical costs for the medical services contract at the Correctional Work Center. The funds for this budget adjustment were transferred out of 101-39000, Unassigned Fund Balance into 101-54220-399, Other Contracted Services. The Mayor noted the cost of medical has increased but the service provided is better than the previous provider. There was no objection.

Superintendent Salandy introduced Pastor John Spurgeon to the Board. Pastor Spurgeon has been actively counseling inmates at the workhouse for over two years. He has been a big encouragement to the inmates as well as the employees. Superintendent Salandy and the board members praised his work and encouraged him to keep up the good work.

Superintendent Salandy noted he has been working with Barry in county maintenance and representatives from Trane regarding the issues with the chiller. We have two systems and one system is down. Trane took some samples and the report should be back this week.

Captain Cope noted Prescotech Inc. has hired two inmates. Prescotech is a packing and insulation company. So far, we have at least 14 inmates in the work release program and should continue working after their release date. Their wages go towards paying child support, housing, gps tracking device charges, etc. Mayor recommended the Superintendent report how effective the work release program is to the Public Safety Committee.

Without objection, the next board meeting will be held on Monday, October 14, 2013. There was no objection.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 9:23 am.


