Here are some interesting facts about the JDC STD Program concerning demographics of positive results:

Race:

- 4.0% of "White" detainees tested have tested positive
- 10.9% of "Black" detainees tested have tested positive
- 5.3% of "Hispanic" detainees tested have tested positive
- 0.0% of "Asian" detainees tested have tested positive
- 0.0% of "Other" detainees tested have tested positive

Age:

- 3.9% of 14 year olds tested have tested positive
- 4.6% of 15 year olds tested have tested positive
- 4.0% of 16 year olds tested have tested positive
- 8.9% of 17 year olds tested have tested positive
- 9.3% of 18 year olds tested have tested positive

Gender:

- 3.4% of all males tested have tested positive
- 13.4% of all females tested have tested positive
