**D) EXPENDITURE REPORT**

The next matter before the Board was the expenditure report. The Board reviewed the June, July and August account analysis, State Litter Pickup Report, ABL & ICS Solutions commission checks, yearly activity report, work release program, and the Smyrna board bill check. After discussion, Mr. Hartley moved that the expenditure report be approved as published. Seconded by Mr. Gammon. The motion carried unanimously with favorable votes.

Superintendent Salandy noted Friday, September 12, 2014 at noon, the workhouse will have their First Annual Chili Cook-Off and Employee Appreciation Luncheon. This is in conjunction with the United Way campaign. The board members were invited to judge the chili cook-off and they willingly accepted the challenge.

Superintendent informed the board that the American Correctional Association (ACA) audit is scheduled for Monday, February 23, 2015. He stated we have recently had our mock audit and that went well.

Captain Cope stated that he as well as Officer Blake Cox, Sergeants Chris Fly, Ted Hewell, and Tommy London were invited to attend the National Institution of Corrections (NIC) Conference, August 24 to August 29, 2014 in Aurora, Colorado. We were 1 of 5 institutions invited to attend the "Train the Trainer" conference with almost all expenses being paid by the NIC.

Superintendent noted our numbers are going up thanks to our staff's hard work.


Superintendent invited the board members to the prayer breakfast on September 10 at 8:30am.




