The Rutherford County Correctional Work Center Board met for their monthly board meeting on Monday, December 1, 2014.

A) MEETING CALLED TO ORDER

C) APPROVE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING

The first matter before the Board was the minutes of the November 4, 2014 meeting. After discussion, Mr. Asbury moved that the minutes of the October 6, 2014 meeting be approved as published. Seconded by Mrs. Mosby. The motion carried unanimously with favorable votes.

D) EXPENDITURE REPORT

The next matter before the Board was the expenditure report. The Board reviewed the October analysis and spread sheet, state litter pickup report, October monthly worker report, ABL & ICS Solutions commission checks, yearly activity report, work release program, and the Smyrna board bill check. Mr. Hartley asked about Dr. Rudd's contract. Superintendent noted he is waiting on the Trane invoice for repair of the chiller. After discussion, Mrs. Mosby moved that the expenditure report be approved as published. Seconded by Mr. Hartley. The motion carried unanimously with favorable votes.

E) OTHER BUSINESS, IF ANY

Superintendent asked Mr. Gammon about Winsoms. He stated the Sherriff's Department is moving away from Winsoms. They are looking into the 911 system and the system used by the City of Murfreesboro. He will keep the board updated.

Mayor Burgess inquired about the board bill statement for general sessions, circuit court and Smyrna General Sessions. DUI funds go into the county general fund. The Rutherford County Work Center does not receive any of these funds. Smyrna is the only one of the three that consistently pays.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 8:54am.
