

## 16<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Recovery Courts Report January 26, 2015

- As of January 5, 2015, two new employees joined the Department – Doris Hoffman, Assistant Coordinator and Trey King, Coordinator.
- Attached to this report is the Drug Court and DUI Court statistics for FY2015.
- Currently working on next year's budget, and diligently trying to clean up administrative matters in the department related to program operations, internal controls, and policies and procedures. Main focus thus far has been to ensure all policies and procedures are up to date, code of ethics is in place, grant reporting and requirements are being met, and to begin working on securing funding for next year's grants.
- Also, the Department is in the process of trying to develop a Veteran's Court and hope to have a pilot program developed as quickly as possible once funding has been identified and secured. Training for the new Veteran's Court program will be administered by the Federal Bureau of Justice Administration, Justice for Vets, and will take place in September 2015. There is quite a bit of support for this program in this community and Deputy Mayor Jeff Davidson has done a wonderful job of finding resources and information for us to review while we are performing our due diligence in setting up this new recovery court. The Veteran's Court planning team will be meeting with Montgomery County's Veteran's Court personnel on February 3, 2015, in order to see firsthand how their program is administered and operating.
