### **ITEMS UNDER ADVISEMENT**

#### VEHICLE EQUIPMENT, STRIPING & VEHICLE BUILD – SHERIFF’S OFFICE

Seven bids were received and opened on this item on July 18, 2013 and taken under advisement. Major Jacoby O’Gwynne and Sgt. Mike Bailey provided the Committee with a spreadsheet of all items bid and advised it was their recommendation to award the bid to Trucker’s Lighthouse. Policecars Orlando out of Apopka, FL had only bid the striping, which was lower, but the customer service is not local and they can’t drive a car to FL just to have striping repaired or put on. That was the only item that was not the lowest bid and they recommended awarding the striping as well to Trucker’s Lighthouse because they are a local company and are lower on all other items.

“Commissioner Black moved, seconded by Commissioner Cook, to accept the recommendation of Major O’Gwynne and Sgt. Bailey and award the complete bid package to Trucker’s Lighthouse. The motion passed unanimously.”
