Chairman Burgess presided and called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m. with all members present.

MEDICAL SUPPLIES & EQUIPMENT – EMS

Bids were opened on this item on June 10 and taken under advisement. Lennie Fabian provided the committee with a spread sheet outlining the bids received and his recommendation. All are low bid with a few exceptions and that is because of poor quality or they did not fit a piece of equipment currently being used by the EMS.

Joe Russell and Mike Bailey reviewed the three bids thoroughly and reported back to the committee. They said D & D did not comply with Section 1.28 of the bid specifications regarding "Contractor's cost is to be based on the Contractor's cost 5 business days (Monday to Friday) prior to the date of bid opening. Proof is defined as a notarized/certified copy of the contractor's cost. Proof must be submitted to identify the cost of each delivery." Therefore, that left the bid from Tri-Star and Huddleston.

Mr. Russell said the bids are very close and both have a good location as far as a back up location. The diesel is the main difference. Based on that, he recommended awarding the bid to Huddleston because they use a fair amount of diesel.

"Commissioner Ealy moved, seconded by Commissioner Gooch, to award the bid to Huddleston Oil. The motion passed unanimously."

REPAINT & REPAIR COURTHOUSE CUPOLA

Two bids were received:

Four bids were received:



Each bid included unit prices for any additional work needed.

Ben Mankin reviewed the bids thoroughly. Capstone is the low bidder and while he has not done any work with them, he and Anthony Tuggle have both talked with them and they appear to be knowledgeable and capable of performing the necessary work.

“Commissioner Cook moved, seconded by Commissioner Gooch, to award the bid to Capstone Bldg. Solutions in the amount of \$74,977.00 plus the upgraded shingles (\$7,375.00) and drip edge (\$1,540.00) for an amount of \$83,892.00 plus any gutter/downspout replacement that may be necessary as the work is done. The motion passed unanimously.”

There being no further business at this time, Chairman Burgess declared the meeting adjourned at 5:25 p.m.
