Chairman Burgess presided and called the meeting to order with six members present.

VARIOUS PROFESSIONAL SERVICES, INCLUDING NETWORK ADMINISTRATION I & II, DATABASE SERVICES, GIS SERVICES I & II – OIT

The following bids were received on July 29, 2014 and taken under advisement:

Brian Robertson said he and his team had thoroughly reviewed all bids received and would be making a recommendation for the main vendor and a secondary vendor to be used in the event the first one is unavailable. All bidders had agreed to be the back-up vendor if chosen as such.

For Network Administration I & II, the low bid was submitted by Wiser Co.; however they are not a Cisco Gold Partner and that is a requirement. Cisco is the provider of all our network and internet systems. Mr. Robertson recommended Presidio for the primary vendor for both and Pomeroy as the secondary should or if we need them.

“Commissioner Black moved, seconded by Commissioner Ealy, to approve Mr. Robertson’s recommendation for Presidio as the primary vendor and Pomeroy as the secondary. The motion passed unanimously.”

For Database Services, Mr. Robertson recommended Pomeroy as the primary and Presidio as the secondary. He’s worked with Pomeroy in the not-so-distant past and was pleased with their work and they meet all specs.

“Commissioner Cook moved, seconded by Commissioner Shafer, to approve Mr. Robertson’s recommendation for Pomeroy as the primary and Presidio as the secondary for Database Services. The motion passed unanimously.”

For GIS I & II, Mr. Robertson said True North has been the provider, but he would like to recommend the low bidder, Wiser Co., as the primary and True North as secondary. Wiser Co. is locally owned and operated and is a very reputable business.

“Commissioner Black moved, seconded by Commissioner Ealy, to approve Mr. Robertson’s recommendation and award the primary bid to Wiser Co. and secondary to True North. The motion passed unanimously.”

"Commissioner Cook moved, seconded by Commissioner McAdoo, to take the bid under advisement. The motion passed unanimously."


