The Rutherford County Correctional Work Center Board met for their monthly board meeting on Monday, April 14, 2014.

A) MEETING CALLED TO ORDER

Chairman Ernest Burgess called the meeting to order at 8:35am.

C) APPROVE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING

The first matter before the Board was the minutes of the March 10, 2014 meeting. After discussion, Mr. Asbury moved that the minutes of the March 14, 2014 meeting be approved as published. Seconded by Mrs. Mosby. The motion carried unanimously with favorable votes.

D) REPORT OF EXPENDITURES

The Board was presented with the state litter pickup report, account analysis & budget spread sheet, board bill, work release program report, and the ABL & IC Solutions commission reports. Superintendent noted all the lines look good. He noted we will be purchasing the new mattresses this month. He also stated that we are looking into purchasing new inmate pants. After discussion, Mr. Hartley moved that the Expenditure Report be approved as presented. Seconded by Mr. Asbury. The motion carried unanimously with favorable votes.

E) OTHER BUSINESS, IF ANY

Superintendent invited the Board members to the prayer breakfast on Wednesday, April 16, 2014 at 8:30 am and the first annual National Correctional Officers' Day on May 10, 2014 at Barfield Crescent Park. He noted we have invited local agencies and all Tennessee Corrections facilities. Present Ronald Reagan proclaimed the week beginning May 6, 1984 as National Correctional Officers' Week and encouraged people to observe this week with appropriate ceremonies and activities.


The work release program is going smoothly and the Board appreciates the work Sgt. Jason Peralta does for the program.

Superintendent and the Board discussed how the workhouse is set up to send out inmate workers which is cost efficient to the county tax payers but the sheriff's office is using line staff and road staff to accomplish the same thing.

Superintendent noted the Recidivism Rates Report for 2013 shows that recidivism rates for Doors of Hope is 18%; GED students 17% and Positive Parenting 31%. This figure includes those that are rearrested for the same offense and/or other charges. If you only count those rearrested for the same charge these percentage numbers would be lower.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 9:05am.




